What is SOCNAV?

SOCNAV is the Servicemembers Opportunity Colleges degree program for the Navy. SOCNAV-2 consists of accredited colleges that offer associate degree programs on or accessible to Navy installations worldwide. The bachelor's degree equivalent is SOCNAV-4. These civilian colleges have joined together to form networks in which each college accepts credits from all the others. SOCNAV colleges issue SOCNAV Agreements which clearly outline the degree requirements and where your military credits fit in. This SOCNAV Agreement guarantees that you can continue toward your degree even though the Navy may transfer you several times. The SOCNAV system solves the problem of starting your studies at one place and finishing at another.

What is a SOCNAV Home College?

A *home college* is the SOCNAV college where you begin your studies and complete the minimum academic residency; you do not have to take more than 25 percent of the program with your *home college* and these courses can be taken with the college at any time and anywhere — even at sea. The *home college* evaluates your Navy Rate and Rating and other learning experiences, combining them all into a SOCNAV Student Agreement that serves as your contract-for-degree. When you have completed your study plan, the *home college* awards you a degree. Coastline Community College is your *home college*.

What is a SOCNAV Student Agreement?

A *SOCNAV Student Agreement* is the form on which the home college makes a complete evaluation of the college credit you should receive on the basis of your Navy Rate and Rating, testing, and other courses taken. It also lists courses remaining to be completed and serves as your checklist for future studies at SOCNAV network colleges anywhere else in the world. It is your contract, your degree plan, and a road map to program completion.
